Why a Wild Flower Show?

Onam is a festival of flowers – but wild blooms are disappearing. Loss of natural biodiversity & lifestyle changes have reduced traditional knowledge. This show revives heritage, builds awareness, and promotes conservation of native flora within human habitats.

Exhibition Highlights

- Wild flowers, fruits & plants collected from home yards, roadsides, fields & village habitats.
- Displays tagged with Scientific, Common & Malayalam Names + major uses.
- Popular entries: Thumba, Mukkutti, Arali, Kadali, Kattuchethi, Thondippazham, Paruthikkai, Koovalam, Pichi, Thechi, Mandaram, etc.
- Native fruits & plants in pots/packs.
- Student exhibitors will explain the uniqueness of their collections.

Participation

Who can join: Schools and colleges only (institutional participation). Department-wise registrations from within a college are not permitted.

- Team size: 10–20 students plus 1–2 teachers.
- Competitions: Separate categories for schools and colleges.
- Items: Students should collect local flowers, plants, fruits, or tubers from their locality; carry out scientific identification; document traditional uses; bring the materials to Naalumanikkaattu; and arrange them as in a flower show.
- Reporting at the venue: On or before 10:30 a.m.
- Provisions: Organisers will provide desks for each participating institution. Schools/colleges must bring any additional materials required for the display.

Recognition:

- Certificates for all institutions, teachers, and students.
- Prizes:
 - 1st Prize – ₹ 3000 + Memento
 - 2nd Prize – ₹ 2000 + Memento
 - 3rd Prize – ₹ 1000 + Memento
